The library of the National Institute of Polar Research (NIPR) has been publishing some academic journals and "JARE Data Reports". "Antarctic Record"(AR), one of NIPR academic

journals, began publication since 1957. "Antarctic Record" is a report of the first Japanese Antarctic Research Expedition.

Recently all "Antarctic Record" articles are available at the platform of CiNii produced by the National Institute of Informatics. AR is not only journal but also All our journals, except for "Polar Science", are Open Access. This attempt began in 2003. Other journals are also available there. How did we do this.

Next, we are also providing e-texts of "Antarctic Record", and other NIPR journals, "JARE Data Reports" from the OPAC server of our library. We have been uploading these articles from

2003 on the OPAC sever of our library system. How to access these e-texts and what is different.

In my report paper, how to use these two sites, how many access to our journals at the CiNii site in a year. And in this report, two introductions are included. One is the cue of

the launching "Polar Science" and new special MERGE issue. The other is the introduction
