

How to order biota by divers at BAH

Information for guest lecturers and guest researches at BAH

Student courses and guest researches at the BAH can order biota by the BAH scientific diving group. To coordinate the procurement of biota by our scientific dive group in time and to your complete satisfaction, please follow the below instructions:

Biota are ordered via Andreas Wagner (room nr. 31 / phone nr: 2327) or Margret Krüß (room nr. 1, phone nr. 3231).


To submit an order, please use the **BAH biota order form** for dive samples. You can get this form our English web-page (www.awi.de/en/infrastructure/underwater/scientific_diving/)

Sampling is scheduled twice a week (Tuesday and Thursday) if weather conditions allow diving. Please submit your order at least **14 days before** it is needed to ensure in-time delivery.

All biota orders are listed (by date of scheduled delivery and name of orderer) in the **online BAH dive plan**. This plan is also online available under the above link.

A **nominal fee of 60 Euro is asked per ½ day sampling cruise off Helgoland¹**. The total fee for all biota orders during your stay is charged at the end of your stay by invoice or via a valid AWI cost number.

If you (or a member of your visiting group) are certified as „geprüfter Forschungstaucher“ or „European Scientific Diver“, you are welcome to join our dive team for biota sampling around Helgoland. **In this case, no nominal fee is charged for the sampling.** If you want to join the BAH dive team, please contact the AWI/BAH Center for Scientific Diving at least 4 weeks prior to your planned stay (scientific.diving@awi.de).

¹ Please be aware, that sampling biota around Helgoland by scientific divers requires a full dive team (three divers) and additional ship logistics. The minimal fee accounted for the biota delivery service from 2009 on by the AWI never covers these costs but allows us to provide this unique service on a long term scale,
